

KFDA Committee Descriptions

Organization Committee

The organization committee does the critical work of establishing consensus and cooperation by building partnerships among the various groups in the community that have a stake in your commercial district – no easy task! Downtown Design Committee

The Design Committee plays an important role in shaping the public image and improving the physical landscape of our Downtown, making it an attractive place for residents, visitors, business owners, and potential investors alike. Klamath Piano Project (Subcommittee of DESIGN)
